WILL I HAVE TO PAY?

We want our courses to be as accessible as possible for everyone, no matter their income or employment status.

Students will not pay tuition fees* if enrolling onto:

- Maths/English GCSE or Functional Skills Entry to Level 2 if you do not already hold a C/4 or above
- ESFA and 19+ if living in the WMCA and earning less than £32000 (gross per annum) or unemployed
- ESFA and 19+ if living outside the WMCA and earning less than £25000 (gross per annum) or unemployed
- Your First Full Level 2 and 19-23-year-olds
- Your First Full Level 3 and 19-23-year-olds
- Your First Full Level 3 and 24+ if earning less than £32000 (gross per annum) or unemployed and live in the WMCA

Some adults enrolling onto a level 3 course which is part of the 'FREE Courses for Jobs' offer who have not already achieved a full level 3 or who do already have a full level 3 but are unemployed or on a low wage will be fully funded and entitled to fee remission.


